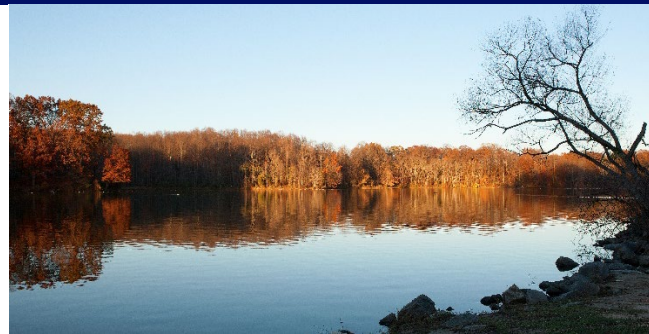

EXCESS PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Description:

Properly dispose of any pesticide meeting “pesticide” definition at [KRS 217B.040](#).

AWQA Minimum Requirements:

As stated in [KRS 217B.190](#), NO person shall discard or store any pesticide or pesticide containers in a manner as to cause injury to humans, vegetation, crops, livestock, wildlife, or pollinating insects, or to pollute any waterway in a way harmful to any wildlife.

Recommendations:

Periodically inspect pesticide containers for deterioration. Dispose of unusable excess agricultural pesticides according to a state Agricultural Chemical Collection Program (502-573-0282). Consider existing inventory when planning for use of spray material.
