Real Alloy Recycling, LLC of 805 Gardener Lane, Morgantown, Kentucky 42261 has applied to the Kentucky Division for Air Quality for a significant revision to the permit to construct/operate a Secondary Smelting and Refining of Aluminum facility at 805 Gardener Lane, Morgantown, Kentucky 42261. The plant is classified as a Title V major source due to its emissions of non-hazardous regulated air pollutants and hazardous air pollutants. Construction authorized by this permit will increase overall potential emissions of NOx by 10 tons per year, PT (filterable only) by 12 tons per year, PM<sub>10</sub> by 14 tons per year, PM<sub>2.5</sub> by 6.5 tons per year, and VOC by 24 tons per year.

Any person who requests a public hearing must state the issues to be raised at the hearing. If the Division finds that a hearing will contribute to the decision-making process by clarifying significant issues affecting the draft permit, a hearing will be announced. All relevant comments will be considered in issuing the proposed permit. U.S. EPA has up to 45 days following issuance of the proposed permit to submit comments.
