Kentucky Division of Forestry is offering several paid internships for the 2024 summer season. Interns will work in the field within the Forest Stewardship, Timber Harvesting Compliance, & State Forests Programs.

Duration: Mid-May to mid-August, with an opportunity to extend into the fall.

Locations: Internships are offered at various locations throughout Kentucky, including KDF's Morehead Branch and Campbellsville Branch Offices and at Kentucky Ridge State Forest.

Compensation: \$15/hour, full-time.

Qualifications: Student in pursuit of a degree in forestry, environmental science, biology, physical science, or a recent graduate, with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Strong communication, technical and analytical skills.
