COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY MINE SAFETY REVIEW COMMISSION ORDER

WHEREAS, KRS 351.182(8) provides for a minimum 10 panel urine testing protocol acceptable for the establishment of drug-free status for miner certification under KRS Chapter 351, and further provides that "the remaining panels to be used in the urine test shall be set by order of the Mine Safety Review Commission no later than June 1 of each year," and

WHEREAS, the Mine Safety Review Commission has investigated and concluded that the following substances should also be included in the testing, as their presence is inappropriate for drug-free status under KRS 352.182;

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that pursuant to KRS 351.182(8)(k), in addition to the ten (10) panel test set out in KRS 351.182 (8) (a)-(j), the urine panels shall include testing for presence of the following substances:

- Designer Stimulants, including Mitragynine (Kratom) and the current sub-contracted certified drug testing lab panels, see labhttps://eec.ky.gov/Natural-Resources/Mining/Mine-Safety/Documents/DTGI-2.pdf for current list;
- Extended Synthetic Cannabinoids, including the current sub-contracted certified drug testing lab panels, see labhttps://eec.ky.gov/Natural-Resources/Mining/Mine-Safety/Documents/DTGI-2.pdf for current list;
- 3. 3,4-methylenedioxy-methamphetamine (MDMA) commonly known as Ecstasy, including the current sub-contracted certified drug testing lab panels, see labhttps://eec.ky.gov/Natural-Resources/Mining/Mine-Safety/Documents/DTGI-2.pdf for current list.
