Greg Henrich is the Vice President of Transmission Operations and Power Supply at Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) and is accountable for real-time operation of TVA's bulk transmission system and power supply for the 10 million people of the Tennessee Valley. He is currently leading a grid modernization effort to prepare TVA for the grid of tomorrow. He has been a member of the NERC Operating Committee, North American Transmission Forum, an EPRI advisor, and Southeast Energy Exchange Market Board member as a representative for TVA.

While at TVA, Greg served as a leader setting direction for the twenty-year asset strategy, planning the transmission system, overseeing transmission maintenance, developing telecommunication planning and maintenance strategy, and as a NERC certified system operator.
