Kentucky Municipal Energy Agency of 1700 Eastpoint Parkway, Suite 220, Louisville, KY 40223 has applied to the Kentucky Division for Air Quality for a permit to construct/operate an electrical power generation facility at 1757 AC Slaton Road, Madisonville, KY 42431. The plant is classified as a Title V major source due to its emissions of non-hazardous regulated air pollutants and hazardous air pollutants. This permit contains practically enforceable limitations to restrict this source's potential emissions of CO, NO_x and VOC to less than PSD major stationary source thresholds.

For a period of 30 days the Division is soliciting comments on the draft permit. The first day of the 30 day period is the day this notice is posted on the website above. A virtual public hearing has been scheduled on May 14, 2025, at 6:00 P.M. Eastern Standard Time. If no one contacts the Division to request a public hearing before the close of business on May 9, 2025, it will be canceled.
