Pittsburgh Glass Works, LLC of 2290 Menelaus Rd., Berea, KY 40403 has applied to the Kentucky Division for Air Quality for a permit to construct/operate an Automotive Glass Manufacturing facility at 2290 Menelaus Rd., Berea, KY 40403. The facility requested conditional major status due to newly added emission units. This permit contains federally-enforceable limitations to restrict this source's potential emissions to less than a major source threshold.

For a period of 30 days the Division will accept comments on the draft permit and afford the opportunity for a public hearing. Any person who requests a public hearing must state the issues to be raised at the hearing. If the Division finds that a hearing will contribute to the decision-making process by clarifying significant issues affecting the draft permit, a hearing will be announced.
