## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING DIVISION FOR AIR QUALITY KENTUCKY 111(d) PLAN REVISION PROPOSED ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION AMENDMENT

The Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet will conduct a virtual public hearing on February 24, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. (EST). This hearing will be held to receive comments on the following proposed administrative regulation amendment:

## 401 KAR 61:036 Emission guidelines and compliance times for municipal solid waste landfills.

The proposed administrative regulation amendment to 401 KAR 61:036 provides for the control of emissions from existing municipal solid waste landfills. This administrative regulation amendment will be included in the Kentucky 111(d) plan. Final amendments to the regulation will be submitted to U.S. EPA as part of a state 111(d) plan.

This hearing is open to the public and all interested persons will be given the opportunity to present testimony. To assure that all comments are accurately recorded, the Division requests that oral comments presented at the hearing are also provided in written form, if possible. It is not necessary that the hearing be held or attended in order for persons to comment on the proposed administrative regulation.
