## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING DIVISION FOR AIR QUALITY PROPOSED ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION AMENDMENTS

The Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet will conduct a virtual public hearing on December 22, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. (Eastern Time). This hearing will be held to receive comments on the following proposed administrative regulation amendments:

401 KAR 60:005. 40 C.F.R. Part 60 standards of performance for new stationary sources.

## 401 KAR 63:002. 40 C.F.R. Part 63 national emissions standards for hazardous air pollutants

The proposed amendments to these administrative regulations update them to align with the federal regulations codified in 40 C.F.R. Parts 60 and 63. These updates ensure that the Energy and Environment Cabinet retains delegation of authority for implementing and enforcing the standards pursuant to Section 111 and 112 of the Clean Air Act.

This hearing is open to the public and all interested persons will be given the opportunity to present testimony. To assure that all comments are accurately recorded, the Division requests that oral comments presented at the hearing are also provided in written form, if possible. It is not necessary that the hearing be held or attended in order for persons to comment on the proposed administrative regulation. If no request for a public hearing is received by December 15, 2025, the hearing will be cancelled, and notice of the cancellation will be posted at <a href="https://eec.ky.gov/Environmental-Protection/Air/Pages/Public-Notices.aspx">https://eec.ky.gov/Environmental-Protection/Air/Pages/Public-Notices.aspx</a>. Written comments should be sent to the contact person and must be received by December 31, 2025, to be considered part of the public record.
