401 KAR 60:005. 40 C.F.R. Part 60 standards of performance for new stationary sources. 401 KAR 63:002. 40 C.F.R. Part 63 national emission standards for hazardous air pollutants.

The proposed amendments to these administrative regulations will update existing language to include amendments to 40 C.F.R. Part 60 and 40 C.F.R. Part 63 that have been promulgated by the U.S. EPA.

This virtual hearing is open to the public and all interested persons will be given the opportunity to present testimony. Please note that registration is required to participate in this hearing. To participate, you must send your name, affiliation, mailing address and email address to the contact person. To assure that all comments are accurately recorded, the Division requests that oral comments presented at the hearing are also provided in written form, if possible. It is not necessary that the hearing be held or attended in order for persons to comment on the proposed regulatory amendments.
