Financial Considerations

- Gas
 - Electricity
 - heat
- Digestate
- Renewable Electricity Credits
- Waste disposal fees
 - Operating and maintenance





Renewable Electricity Credits

- Represents the environmental attributes of a megawatt hour of renewable electricity
- Voluntary market
 - Utility green power programs
 - Carbon credit/offsetting
 - Compliance market
 - States with renewable electricity mandates
 - Kentucky can sell into Ohio
 - Generators can manage their own sales or work with a broker.



Electricity Options

- Consumed behind the meter
 - Reduces electricity cost
 - Reduces demand charges
- Net metered with the utility
 - 30 kilowatt maximum
 - Meter will spin backwards when you are feeding the grid
- Sold to the utility
 - Qualifying Facility
 - Utility must purchase the electricity
 - Pays the avoided cost rate
 - Generator keeps RECs



Electricity Options

- Sold to a nonutility
 - Common arrangement in other states
 - Model not yet fully explored in Kentucky
 - RECs may or may not convey
- Sold to the Tennessee Valley Authority
 - Standard offer for renewable electricity
 - Program varies depending on capacity
 - RECs convey
 - Applicable to projects in the TVA service area



TVA Renewable Electricity Offers

Generation Partners

- Applicable for systems less than 200 kilowatts
- Currently will pay retail electric rate + any fuel adjustment cost + 3 cents

- Standard Offer
 - Applicable for Systems 200 kilowatts or over
 - Base Prices ranges from 3.793 ¢/kwh to 15.966 ¢/kwh
 - Average is 5.611 ¢/kwh
