

Public Notice

Pursuant to the public notification requirements of KRS 13A.270, the Kentucky Division of Water (Division) has enclosed for your information the following proposed administrative regulation amendments:

401 KAR 8:075 - Consumer confidence reports and public notification.

This administrative regulation changes drinking water system requirements for consumer confidence reports and public notifications.

401 KAR 8:250 - Inorganic and organic chemical sampling, analytical techniques, maximum contaminant levels, radionuclides, and secondary standards.

This administrative regulation makes changes to drinking water standards for inorganic and organic chemical sampling, analytical techniques, maximum contaminant levels, radionuclides, and secondary standards for drinking water systems.

401 KAR 8:300 - Lead and copper.

This administrative regulation changes drinking water system requirements regarding lead and copper.

The Division filed the proposed administrative regulations with the Legislative Research Commission on September 3, 2026. The proposed administrative regulation will be published in the October 1, 2026, version of Administrative Register of Kentucky.

A public hearing on these administrative regulations shall, if requested, be held on November 23, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. (Eastern Time); 9:00 a.m. (Central Time). The Zoom invitation will be emailed to each requester the week prior to the scheduled hearing. Individuals interested in attending the virtual hearing shall notify this agency in writing by November 16, 2026, five (5) workdays prior to the hearing of their intent to attend. If no notification of intent to attend the hearing is received by that date, the hearing may be cancelled. This hearing is open to the public. Any person who attends virtually will be given the opportunity to comment on the proposed administrative regulation. The virtual public hearing will be recorded, and the recording provided upon a written request to the contact person. Written comments shall be accepted through November 30, 2026. Send written notification of intent to attend the public hearing or written comments on the proposed administrative regulation to the contact person.

The public hearing is accessible to any person with disabilities. Reasonable accommodation, including auxiliary aids and services necessary to participate in the hearing may be made to the contact person at least five (5) working days prior to the hearing.
