Tentative Approval of Two Hazardous Waste Permit Modifications

The Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet (Cabinet), Division of Waste Management (Division), has tentatively approved two modifications to the existing hazardous waste permit for the Blue Grass Army Depot (BGAD). The modifications are for the chemical weapon disposal facility known as the Blue Grass Chemical Agent-Destruction Pilot Plant (BGCAPP). The two modifications are:

- Off-site Shipment and Disposal of Agent Hydrolysate. A modification to allow off-site shipment of agent hydrolysate to a permitted hazardous waste incinerator.
- Uncontaminated Rocket Motor Storage. A modification to allow up to 29 existing BGAD igloos to be used to store uncontaminated rocket motors after separation from the rocket warheads.

The U.S. Army is the owner of the permitted facility. BGAD is located at 431 Battlefield Memorial Highway, Richmond, Kentucky. The BGAD facility contact is Ramesh Melarkode (859-779-6268). Bechtel Parsons Blue Grass Joint Venture (BPBG) is the operator of BGCAPP. The BPBG contact is John McArthur (859-625-6447).

What will be done and why?

The hazardous waste regulations require that proposed hazardous waste permits or modifications include a thorough review of all required information to ensure that all program requirements are met, and that all interested parties have an opportunity to review and comment upon the proposed actions. The Division has completed a review of the respective permit applications and has prepared a draft Permit. The draft Permit sets forth conditions for conducting the hazardous waste operations. The Division has determined that the applications meet the requirements set forth in the statutes and regulations.

The permit modifications includes detailed conditions required under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) and the Commonwealth of Kentucky statutes and regulations to ensure protectiveness of human health and the environment.

How can I tell the Division what I think about these tentative approvals?

Public involvement is encouraged and comments are welcome. Anyone wishing to comment on the tentative decision to approve these permitting actions should submit comments on or before **September 8, 2021**, the close of the public comment period. Additionally, a public meeting will be conducted on **September 1, 2021, at 6:00 pm** in the Perkins Building, Kit Carson Drive, at Eastern Kentucky University, Richmond, Kentucky, followed immediately by a public hearing at the same location.

All comments received by the close of the public comment period noted above will be considered when making a final decision on the proposed permitting actions. Anyone submitting comments will be sent a "response to public comments" document specifying any changes made or not made, with the reasons why, as a result of the comment(s) submitted. Any person who may be aggrieved by the final decision on these proposed permit modifications may file with the cabinet a petition which sets forth the grounds of the objection and demand a hearing pursuant to KRS 224.10-420(2).
