## TENTATIVE DECISION TO ISSUE A HAZARDOUS WASTE POST-CLOSURE RENEWAL PERMIT

The Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet (Cabinet) Division of Waste Management (Division) has reached a tentative decision to issue a hazardous waste post-closure renewal permit to Dunaway Timber Company, Inc. (Dunaway) for continued continue care and management of the closed landfill at the facility. Dunaway Timber is located one (1) mile north of Fordsville, Kentucky on KY Highway 1700 in Ohio County. # Why does Dunaway Timber Company, Inc. need to renew their Hazardous Waste Post-Closure Permit Application?

The initial hazardous waste permit for the facility was in 1995 for a 10 year term. The permit was renewed for another 10 year term in 2007 for post-closure care of the closed hazardous waste landfill. The Cabinet is renewing the Post-Closure Permit to Dunaway for a 10 year term to legally enforce and guide maintenance and monitoring of the closed landfill and to require corrective action of other impacted areas. Issuance of the Post-Closure Permit will result in the continuation of legally binding stipulations to guide such maintenance and any necessary corrective actions.

The purpose of the Post-Closure Permit is to make certain that any current and future operations and developments use and manage the site in compliance with regulatory requirements. The Post-Closure Permit outlines all steps that Dunaway will take to ensure the protection of human health and the environment.

The Cabinet will consider all comments, received by the close of the public comment period on September 5, 2021, in making a final decision. Anyone submitting comments will be mailed a "response to public comments" document specifying any changes made or not made (with reasons why) as a result of the comment(s) submitted.

Any person who may be aggrieved by the final decision to accept this post-closure renewal approval may file a petition with the Cabinet a petition that sets forth the grounds of the objection and demands a hearing pursuant to KRS 224.10-420(2).
