**TENTATIVE DECISION TO ISSUE A HAZARDOUS WASTE CORRECTIVE ACTION**  
**RENEWAL PERMIT**

The Kentucky Environmental and Public Protection Cabinet (Cabinet) Division of Waste Management (Division) has reached a tentative decision to issue a hazardous waste corrective action renewal permit to Lexmark International, Inc. (Lexmark) for continued corrective action. The facility is located at 740 West New Circle Road in Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky. The facility contact person is Mr. Ralph Hill, Counsel, EH&S, Lexmark International, Inc. – (859) 232-7857.

**Why does Lexmark International, Inc. need to renew their Hazardous Waste Corrective Action Permit Application?** The initial hazardous waste permit for the facility was issued to International Business Machines Corporation (IBM) in 1983. The permit was subsequently transferred to Lexmark in 1991, and the existing permit was issued in 1995 for a 10 year term for hazardous waste storage activities and corrective action. The permit was renewed for another 10 year term in 2007. All of the regulated hazardous waste storage units addressed by the current permit have been verified closed. The draft Permit Renewal is required for the continuation of maintenance and monitoring during the 30 year post-closure period.

**What will the Cabinet do with the comments they receive?**

The Cabinet will consider all comments, received by the close of the public comment period on **December 6, 2021**, in making a final decision. Anyone submitting comments will be mailed a “response to public comments” document specifying any changes made or not made (with reasons why) as a result of the comment(s) submitted.

Any person who may be aggrieved by the final decision to accept this post-closure renewal approval may file a petition with the Cabinet a petition that sets forth the grounds of the objection and demands a hearing pursuant to KRS 224.10-420(2).
