The Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet (Cabinet), Division of Waste Management (Division), has reached a tentative decision to approve a Post-Closure Permit for Continental Refining Company, LLC. Why does Continental Refining Company, LLC. need to renew their Hazardous Waste Post-Closure Permit Application? The initial hazardous waste permit for the facility was in 2014 for a 10 year term for post-closure care of the closed hazardous waste landfill. The Cabinet is renewing the Post-Closure Permit to Continental for a 10 year term to legally enforce and guide maintenance and monitoring of the closed landfill and to require corrective action of other impacted areas. Issuance of the Post-Closure Permit will result in the continuation of legally binding stipulations to guide such maintenance and any necessary corrective actions.

The purpose of the Post-Closure Permit is to make certain that any current and future operations and developments use and manage the site in compliance with regulatory requirements. The Post-Closure Permit outlines all steps that Continental will take to ensure the protection of human health and the environment.

Any person who may be aggrieved by the final decision to accept this post-closure renewal approval may file a petition with the Cabinet a petition that sets forth the grounds of the objection and demands a hearing pursuant to KRS 224.10-420(2).
