

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Agency Interest No. 2915 / Application No. APE20200001

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on April 1, 2020 from Air Products & Chemical Inc to renew the solid waste permit for their residual landfill and the special waste permit for their landfarm in Marshall County. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 079-00009 and 079-00013 to September 30, 2030.

The name and mailing address of the permit applicant is Air Products & Chemicals Inc, 7201 Hamilton Blvd, Allentown, PA 18195. The facility can be accessed by traveling from Louisville by merging onto I-65 S, take exit 91 for US 31W N/KY-61 toward Paducah/Elizabethtown. Keep left follow signs for Owensboro/Paducah/Western Ky Pkwy merge onto I-69 S/Western Ky Pkwy for 37.5 miles, take exit 68B for I-24 W toward Paducah, Merge onto I-24W/I-69 S for 14.6 miles Take exit 27 for US 62 toward Kentucky Dam/Calvert City, turn right onto US 62 W for 1.5 miles, turn right on S Main St for 2.9 miles, facility will be on the right.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, Second Floor, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record.
