

PUBLIC NOTICE

Agency Interest No. 3287 / Permit No. 092-00009

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on May 3, 2021 from Bluegrass Containment LLC to renew the solid waste permit for their landfill in Ohio County. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 092-00009 to September 11, 2031.

The name and mailing address of the permit applicant is Bluegrass Containment LLC, 2673 Outer Loop, Louisville, KY 40219. The contact person is William Chlebowy, who can be reached by telephone at (502) 710-0519. The facility physical address is 96 Mt Zion Rd, Beaver Dam, KY 42320. The facility can be accessed by traveling from Beaver Dam by heading west on Old Beaver Dam Rd toward Mine Fork Rd/Taylor Mines Fork Rd for 0.1 mile, turn right onto Highland Dr./ Taylor Mines Fork Rd. for 0.5 mile and turn right onto US-62 E 1.0 mile. Turn right onto Horton Rd/Horton-Mt Pleasant Rd/Mt Zion Rd 0.4 mile then turn left to stay on Horton Rd /Horton-Mt Pleasant Rd/Mt Zion Rd. The facility will be on the left.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Boulevard, Second Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record.
