Calgon Carbon Permit Renewal

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on April 12, 2022 from Calgon Carbon Corporation to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 010-00010 for Calgon Carbon Corporation in Boyd County to October 26, 2027.

The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
