

PUBLIC NOTICE

Agency Interest No. 37295 / Permit No. 010-00011

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on March 23, 2021 from Cleveland-Cliffs Steel Corporation to renew the solid waste permit for the residual landfill in Boyd County, formerly called the A.K. Steel Corporation Norton Landfill. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 010-00011 to October 26, 2026.

The name and mailing address of the permit applicant is Cleveland-Cliffs Steel Corporation, 170 Armco Road, Ashland, KY 41101. The contact person is James Kemp who can be reached by telephone at (513) 425-6177. The facility physical address is Junction of 23rd and Front Street, Ashland, KY, 41101. The facility can be accessed by traveling via I-64 E from Lexington to US-60 E for 102 miles. Take Exit 181 for US-60 and turn left onto US-60 for 2.3 miles. Then, turn left onto KY-5 N for 11.6 miles, turn right onto Russell Road 0.1 mile, and turn left onto Armco Rd. Turn right for 0.6 mile to stay on Armco Rd. The facility will be on the left.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Boulevard, Second Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only. To make an appointment or request materials in an alternate format, submit a written request to eec.kora@ky.gov at least 72 hours prior to the desired review date.
