

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Agency Interest No. 1642 / Application No. APE20200002

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on April 10, 2020 from the US Army Garrison Fort Knox to renew the solid waste permit, including the Greater-than-one-acre Construction Demolition Debris Landfill activity in Hardin County. The application proposes to extend the expiration date to November 12, 2030.

The name and address of the permit applicant and facility is US Army Garrison, 125 6th Ave., Fort Knox, KY 40121-5719. The facility can be accessed by traveling from Louisville by following I-65 S and KY 841 W/Gene Snyder Fwy to US 31 W S/US 60 W for approximately 20 miles. Take exit 1 from KY-841 W/Gene Snyder, then follow US-31 W S/60 W to Baker Rd in Hardin County for 14.5 miles. Take the Brandenburg Station Rd exit, turn right onto Brandenburg Station Rd for 0.6 mile, and then turn right to continue on Brandenburg Station Rd. Turn left onto Baker Rd, the facility will be on the right.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, Second Floor, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record.
