

PUBLIC NOTICE
Glasgow Regional Landfill Permit Renewal

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on October 24, 2022 from the City of Glasgow to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 005-00001 for Glasgow Regional Landfill in Barren County to May 01, 2028.

The physical address of the facility is 400 Glen Garry Rd, Glasgow, KY 42141 and the mailing address of the applicant is 126 E Public Sq, Ste 100, PO Box 278, Glasgow, KY 42142. The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
