

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
Henderson Landfill Permit Renewal

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on April 19, 2022 from the city of Henderson to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 051-00007 for Henderson Landfill in Henderson County to November 5, 2027.

The physical address of the facility is 790 Wolf Hills Road, Henderson, KY 42420 and the mailing address of the applicant is 222 1<sup>st</sup> St, PO Box 716, Henderson, KY 42420. The facility can be reached by taking KY 41 North from Henderson and turning right onto Wolf Hills Road. Then travel approximately 1.2 miles to the landfill entrance.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only. Anyone wishing to request a public hearing, or wishing to make comments on the application, should submit the request(s) or comment(s) in writing to Danny Anderson, P.E., Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, Second Floor, 300 Sower Blvd., Frankfort, KY 40601, no later than the close of business on June 3, 2022, the end of the 30-day public comment period.
