Pursuant to Agency Interest No. 2939 / Application No. APE20200003

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on September 17, 2020 from ISP Chemicals LLC to renew the solid waste permit for their residual landfill in Marshall County. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 079-00012 for to June 30, 2026.

The name and mailing address of the facility and permit applicant is ISP Chemicals LLC, 455 N Main Street, PO Box 37, Calvert City, KY 42029.
