Pursuant to Agency Interest No. 2101 / Application No. APE20200004

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on June 15, 2020 from Kosmos Cement Company LLC to renew the solid waste permit for their waste-to-energy and waste tire accumulator permit in Jefferson County. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 056-00083 for 5 years.
