Application for a new Greater-Than-One Acre CDD Landfill
Mason County Fiscal Court
Agency Interest No. 3013 / Application Activity No. APE20130001

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch (DWM) has reviewed an application from Mason County Fiscal Court to apply for a new Greater-Than-One Acre CDD Landfill located in Mason County. The application has been determined to be complete and the Cabinet has issued a draft permit.

The Construction Demolition Debris disposal area will be 13.3 acres. The Contained and Residual Landfills' disposal areas will remain 41.0 and 21.4 acres, respectively. The permit boundary, which includes disposal areas, borrow areas and facility operations areas, is proposed to be increased from 544.0 acres to 736.2 acres.

The proposed landfill location may be accessed by taking State Route KY 11/Fleming Rd south from the intersection with US-62/US-68 in Maysville, KY for approximately 2.8 miles and turn left onto State Route KY-9/AA Highway. Continue on KY-9/AA Highway for approximately 2.8 miles and turn right onto Clarkson-Sherman Rd, where the proposed landfill is to be located.

The permitting action is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Blvd., 2nd Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601.

Anyone wishing to make written comments on this application may submit them in writing to Danny Anderson, Branch Manager, Solid Waste Branch, Division of Waste Management, 300 Sower Blvd., 2nd Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601, no later than the close of business on October 11, 2019, the end of the 30-day public comment period. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
