

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Agency Interest No. 3188 / Application No. APE20200001

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on October 19, 2020 from Rumpke of Kentucky, Inc. to renew the solid waste permit for their disposal facility, including their contained landfill. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 087-00003 for the Montgomery County Landfill to April 8, 2026.

The name and mailing address of the permit applicant is Rumpke of Kentucky, Inc., 3990 Generation Drive Cincinnati, OH 45251. The facility can be accessed by traveling from Mt Sterling, KY by heading north on N Bank St toward W. High St. Take KY-11 S/Levee Rd to Larison Rd for 7.7 miles. Turn left onto Larison Rd for 0.7 miles. The facility will be on the left.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, Second Floor, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record.
