

PUBLIC NOTICE

Agency Interest No. 514 / Permit No. 018-00003

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on August 24, 2021 from City of Murray to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 018-00003 for Murray Landfill in Calloway County to December 31, 2026.

The facility physical address is 400 Landfill Rd, Coldwater, KY 42071. The facility can be accessed by traveling west on KY-80, turn right onto Potts Rd, turn left onto Landfill Rd, and destination on the right.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Boulevard, Second Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
