Murray Landfill / Agency Interest No.514 / Application No. APE20260001/ Permit No.018-00003,

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on August 17, 2026, from Murray Landfill in Calloway County to renew the solid waste permit. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 018-00003 for the Murray Landfill to December 31, 2031.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, Second Floor, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
