

PUBLIC NOTICE
Ohio County (Balefill) Landfill Permit Renewal

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on January 14, 2022 from Ohio County Fiscal Court to extend the expiration date of Permit Nos. 092-00001 & 092-00010 for Ohio County (Balefill) Landfill in Ohio County to June 10, 2032.

The physical address of facility is 100 Landfill Lane, Beaver Dam, KY 42320 and the mailing address of the applicant is 130 E Washington St, Ste 215, Hartford, KY 42347. The facility can be accessed by traveling west from Beaver Dam, KY on 7th Street / Goshen Rd. Turn left onto Miller Rd and turn right onto Landfill Ln and arrive at destination.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only. Anyone wishing to request a public hearing, or wishing to make comments on the application, should submit the request(s) or comment(s) in writing to Danny Anderson, P.E., Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, Second Floor, 300 Sower Blvd., Frankfort, KY 40601, no later than the close of business on February 24, 2022, the end of the 30-day public comment period.
