Application for a new Residual Landfill
Owl's Head Alloys, Inc.
Agency Interest No. 163490 / Application Activity No. APE20190001

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch (DWM) has received a Notice of Intent from Owl's Head Alloys, Inc. to apply for a new Residual Landfill located in Butler County.

The applicant proposes a permitted area of approximately 70 acres, of which 4.4 acres is designated for waste disposal. The proposed facility location may be accessed by taking I-65 exit 91 for US-31W N/KY-61 N toward Paducah/Elizabethtown. Follow signs for Owensboro/Paducah/Western Kentucky Pkwy and merge onto Western Kentucky Pkwy. Take exit 94 for KY-79 toward Caneyville/Morgantown. Turn left onto KY-79 S/Morgantown St to continue on KY 79 S for 16.1 miles. Turn left onto US 231 S for 1.8 miles. Turn right onto Veterans Way for 2.0 miles. The proposed site will be on the right.

The permitting action is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Blvd., 2nd Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601.
