Application for a Horizontal Expansion to Pike County Landfill
Agency Interest No. 3688 / Application Activity No. APE20190003

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch (DWM) received a Notice of Intent from Pike County Fiscal Court to apply for a horizontal expansion for the contained landfill in Pike County. The application proposes 41.6 acres of waste disposal area.

The facility location may be accessed from Pikeville by taking Town Mountain Rd for 3.0 miles to US 119 N. Turn right onto US 119 N, then use the right lane to take ramp to US 1426/Burning Fork/Zebulon for 0.6 miles. Continue on Zebulon Hwy for 4.8 miles. Zebulon Hwy turns right and becomes KY 194 E for 0.2 miles. Turn left on Ford Mountain Road, turn left to stay on Ford Mountain Rd for about 0.1 mile. The facility will be on the left.

The name and address of the permit applicant is Pike County Fiscal Court, 146 Main St, Pikeville, KY 41501. The name and address of the facility is Pike County Landfill located at 625 Ford Mountain Rd, Meta, KY 41501. The contact person is Reggie Hickman at (606) 432-6247. The permitting action is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Blvd., 2nd Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601.

The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only. To make an appointment, submit an open records request, or request materials in an alternate format, submit a written request to eec.kora@ky.gov at least 72 hours prior to the desired review date.
