Agency Interest No. 3825 / Permit No. 100-00008

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on February 8, 2021 from Pulaski Grading, LLC to renew the solid waste permit for the residential landfill. The application proposes to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 100-00008 for Pulaski Grading Landfill in Pulaski County to August 5, 2026.

The name and mailing address of the permit applicant is Pulaski Grading LLC, 1700 N Broad Street, Fairborn, OH 45324. The contact person is Robin Jones who can be reached by telephone at (937) 318-5342. The facility physical address is 320 Dixie Bend Road, Burnside, KY 42519. The facility can be accessed from Burnside by traveling southeast on US-27 S/Main St toward Oak St for 4.3 miles. Turn left onto Dixie Bend Rd for 0.5 miles. Facility will be on the left.

The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, Second Floor, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
