

## **PUBLIC NOTICE – PUBLIC MEETING and PUBLIC HEARING**

Modification to a Special Waste Landfarm Permit  
R & R Septic and Excavation, LLC  
Agency Interest No. 128929 / Application Activity No. APE20190002

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch (DWM) has received an application for a Minor Modification to a Special Waste Landfarm to add a facility subplot located in Trimble County.

The facility will receive wastewater from Carriage House Company which prepares private label food products, and the permit applicant proposes to land apply the material at the proposed subplot in Trimble County, Kentucky. If traveling on Highway 421 from Bedford, Kentucky, the proposed subplot is about 4-5 miles north of Bedford and on the right.

The name and address of the permit applicant is R & R Septic and Excavation, LLC, 1357 Bunk Rd, Pleasureville, KY 40057. The contact person is Robert Olds at (502) 461-7347. The address of the proposed subplot is 230 McKinney Farm Rd. The permitting action is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Blvd., 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601.

The Energy and Environment Cabinet has scheduled both a public meeting and a public hearing to be held on August 8, 2019 at the Bedford Elementary School, 204 Mount Pleasant Rd, Bedford, KY 40006. The purpose of the public meeting is to explain the application process and answer questions concerning landfarming and the application submitted by R & R Septic and Excavation, LLC. The public meeting will begin promptly at 5:15 pm. The public hearing, which is an opportunity for the public to make oral comments for the record, will begin at 6:15 pm.

Anyone wishing to make written comments on this application may bring them to the public meeting or hearing or submit them in writing to Danny Anderson, Branch Manager, Solid Waste Branch, Division of Waste Management, 300 Sower Blvd., 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Frankfort, KY 40601, no later than the close of business on August 16, 2019, the end of the 30-day public comment period.
