Southern Waste Services Landfill Permit Renewal

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management (DWM) received a permit renewal application on February 9, 2022 from Southern Waste Services LLC to extend the expiration date of Permit No. 071-00006 for Southern Waste Services Landfill in Logan County to June 29, 2027.

The physical address of the facility is 478 Coopertown Rd., Russellville, KY 42276 and the mailing address is 2673 Outer Loop, Louisville, KY 40219. The permit application is being processed at the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch, 300 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, KY 40601. The application and related information are incorporated into the administrative record and can be reviewed at the Division of Waste Management's Frankfort office between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM weekdays by appointment only.
