Major Modification for Thoroughbred Disposal, LLC  
37952 / APE20190001

The Energy and Environment Cabinet, Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Branch (DWM) has received an application from Thoroughbred Disposal, LLC to apply for a major modification for a vertical expansion greater than two years to an existing Construction & Demolition Debris Greater-than-one-acre Landfill located in Fayette County.

The landfill may be accessed by taking I-64 exit 87 for KY 859. Keep left on the ramp towards Bluegrass Station. Turn left onto Haley Rd/ KY 859. Turn right onto Rockwell Rd, the turn left onto Hedger Ln. The site will be on the left.

The name and address of the permit applicant is Thoroughbred Disposal LLC, 604 Bizzell Dr. Unit 250, Lexington, KY 40510.
