 - Monday through Friday, with occasional Saturdays
- Traffic
 - Material Deliveries (Stone, Geosynthetics, Precast, etc)
- Disturbance
 - Air Dust control
 - Erosion Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)
 - Roadways All soil will be transported on-site

Final Closure Period (FCP) Cap Project

- Site Control
- Control of Site with Fencing and Gates
- ■Sign-in/Sign-out Daily
- All Visitors Must be Escorted
- Level D Protective Clothing
 - Hard Hat
 - Safety Glasses
 - High Visibility Clothing

Final Closure Period (FCP) Cap Project

- Safety/Radiation
- Operating under an approved, very detailed, Construction Management Plan
- Full Time Site Safety Officer/Radiation Safety Officer
 - Performs daily monitoring
- It is extremely unlikely during this final capping phase for a personnel contamination



Final Closure Period (FCP) Cap Project - Training

- OSHA 40-hour HAZWOPER All Workers
 - Includes Radiation Protection Training
- First Aid & CPR
 - Over 50 were trained for this project
- All Workers
 - Emergency Response Training
