Public Notice (PN) Certification

Please fill out this document and attach your accompanying Public Notice documentation.

- Please provide a copy of each format of PN (example: bill card and copy posted).
- Send a completed PN package to KY DOW within ten (10) days of providing notification to your consumers and not before the PN has been delivered to your consumers.
- If you use your annual Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) for the public notification of Tier 3 violations, you must submit a certification of the PN requirements AND a certification of the CCR requirements, all within the allowed time frame of the Public Notice. **Federal Regulation §141.204**
- Include a separate certification for each PWSID that your public water system (PWS) has. You may combine the
 notices and violations on the same certification as long as the timing requirements are met for submitting the
 certification.

To submit, you may mail the document or submit the document as an attachment to **EEC eForm 169**, *Drinking Water Information and Data Submittal*.

Allowed methods of distribution:

(1) Unless directed otherwise by the primacy agency in writing, community water systems must provide notice by:

Primary: (i) Mail or other direct delivery to each customer receiving a bill and to other service connections to which water is delivered by the public water system; and **Secondary:** (ii) Any other method reasonably calculated to reach other persons regularly served by the system, if they would not normally be reached by the notice required in paragraph (c)(1)(i) of this section. Such persons may include those who do not pay water bills or do not have service connection addresses (e.g., house renters, apartment dwellers, university students, nursing home patients, prison inmates, etc.). Other methods may include: Publication in a local newspaper; delivery of multiple copies for distribution by customers that provide their drinking water to others (e.g., apartment building owners or large private employers); posting in public places served by the system or on the Internet; or delivery to community organizations.
