All outside training requires preapproval by the Division of Water to ensure training credit. If you do not receive preapproval you may not receive training credit depending on the course(s) content.

Kentucky Ground Water Association's Annual Well Driller Workshop & Expo is held in March. This is the preferred training source for Kentucky Water Well Drillers required annual training

The Virginia Water Well Association & South Atlantic Jubilee usually send a course list to the DOW for approval before the training event so KY drillers who attend can determine which courses are already pre-reviewed by the Kentucky Division of Water
