




Sediment washing into streams is one of the biggest water quality problems in Kentucky. Sediment muddles up the water, kills or weakens fish and other organisms, and ruins wildlife habitat. It is not difficult to reduce erosion and prevent sediment from leaving construction sites.

Basic Principles for Erosion Prevention

- · Preserve existing vegetation.
- Divert upland runoff around exposed soil.
- Seed/mulch/cover bare soil immediately.
- Use sediment barriers to trap soil in runoff.
- Protect slopes and channels from gullying.
- · Install sediment traps and settling basins.
- Preserve vegetation near all waterways.



KYR00 – Industrial Stormwater Multi-Sector GP

Stormwater discharges directly related to manufacturing, processing, or raw material storage areas are required to obtain a KPDES permit. Facilities covered under the KYR00 General Permit are those with:

- Discharges of stormwater runoff associated with industrial activities
- Discharges of stormwater runoff from sawmills
- •Discharges from the spray-down or intentional wetting of logs at wet deck storage areas
- Discharges of non-contact cooling waters
- Discharges of stormwater runoff from Highway Maintenance
 Garages



Recent Changes:

- KYDOW wanted to include additional types of industries into our stormwater general permit.
- This change incorporated over 155 facilities covered under separate general permits along with at least 30 individual permits.
- This change saves time and money for all parties.
- We used EPAs Multi-Sector General Permit as guidance.
- EPA identifies indicator monitoring requirements for all types of industries. These are:
 - o Total Suspended Solids (TSS) and pH,
 - o Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAHs), and
 - Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD)
- EPAs 2026 MSGP proposes to include indicator monitoring for Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) for some types of industry. KYDOW is not requiring this monitoring.



Recent Changes:

- We incorporated the following indicator monitoring requirements into the KYR00 for all industries:
 - TSS Instead of a limit, has a trigger of 100 mg/L.
 - o pH Limits of 6–9 SU.
 - Oil and Grease instead of PAHs Max Limit of 15 mg/L.
 - COD Report only



Recent Changes:

Each type of industry has its own Effluent Limitations table.

- We incorporated timber facilities previously requiring an individual permit. Permit requirements:
 - Additional monitoring for Hardness and a limit for Zinc of 0.12 mg/L
- We incorporated non-contact cooling waters previously requiring an individual permit. Permit requirements:
 - Additional monitoring for Temperature with a limit of 89 °F and Total Residual Chlorine with a limit of 0.019 mg/L.
- We incorporated Highway Maintenance Garages previously covered under the KYG50 general permit. Permit requirements:
 - Additional monitoring for Chlorides with a limit of 1200 mg/L
 and monitoring for Surfactants if washwaters are discharged.




