# Recent or New Drinking Water Regulations or Rule Changes

---

## Finalized:

- PFAS Rule– April 2024
- CCR Rule – May 2024
- Lead and Copper Rule Revisions – December 2021
- Lead and Copper Rule Improvements – October 2024

## Pending:

- Water System Restructuring Rule (proposed May 2024)
- Microbial and Disinfectant Byproduct Rule (expected to propose a rule in 2025)



# Keep DOW updated – Keep yourself in Compliance

## Update Contact Information

- We cannot work with you if we cannot get ahold of you
- We will call or email for questions and try to fix something before it becomes a violation

## Update sampling sites

- Make sure you get confirmation from DOW before you start using any new sites that you have submitted

## Check sampling schedules on Drinking Water Watch so you know when and what to sample

- Monitoring violations are usually just a system forgetting when a requirement is due
- DOW increased reminders– but we can not remind everyone about everything
