

Save Water

By Fixing Leaks

Find silent toilet leaks with blue or green* food coloring or commercial toilet leak detecting tabs!



***Note: Avoid red food coloring that may stain the bowl**



Leaks inside your toilet can waste up to 200 gallons of water per day. That's a lot of money going down the drain! If you find a leak, please have it repaired as soon as possible.

Save Water

By Fixing Leaks

- 1 Remove the toilet lid and put 4-5 drops of food coloring into the tank.
- 2 Wait 30 minutes. Do not flush.
- 3 If the water in the bowl turns blue there is a leak in the tank.

Leaks occur when the flapper valve doesn't seal. Check for these common issues: a) The chain is snagging, not allowing the flapper to seal; b) the flapper is worn or warped and needs to be replaced

Pro Tip!

Remove the old flapper and take it with you to the hardware store so you can find a matching replacement.
