WHEREAS, Kentucky is home to some of the most beautiful and most biologically diverse waters in the country, and residents of the commonwealth have an important and celebrated connection to rivers, streams, lakes, and wetlands; and

WHEREAS, We are all stewards of Kentucky's water quality, upon which future generations depend; and

WHEREAS, Each Kentuckian is called to help protect our water resources from pollution to ensure that future generations may enjoy them; and

WHEREAS, October 18, 2022, is the 50th Anniversary of the Clean Water Act, which recognizes that access to clean, safe water is a critical human need;
