In the fall of 2018 the Department for Natural Resources, Division of Mine Reclamation & Enforcement was approved for a structural reorganization that abolished the London Regional Office, closed the Prestonsburg Regional Office and approved a new Eastern Kentucky office location in Hazard, Kentucky.
