Subject: Reinstatement of Small Operator Assistance

RAM#77

There are a number of administrative, technical or legal circumstances which could result in the withdrawal, suspension or cancellation of an application for Small Operator Program Assistance. When one of these actions is taken, the operator is notified in writing and informed of the specific reason(s) for the action. In addition, the consultant performing the SOAP funded study is notified by phone to stop all work immediately.

If the problem(s) which lead to the cancellation, suspension or withdrawal action is resolved, the operator must request in writing that the SOAP application be reinstated. The SOAP Branch will not automatically resume assistance without a written request. Upon receipt of the written request from the operator, along with the necessary documentation, SOAP will reinstate the application to its original status and resume assistance.
