Subject: Corporate Permittees - Changes in Name of Permittee
and/or Ownership/Control of Permits

In previous RAM #91, DSMRE announced that a new form would soon be available for corporate permittees to notify DSMRE of changes in the name of a corporate permittee and/or changes in the ownership/control of a corporate permittee. We are happy to say the Division of Permits has completed the new form and helpful instruction materials, which are now available at the Regional Offices and in Frankfort. They are:

- SMP-10, entitled "Notification of Change in Corporate Permittee and/or Corporate Name," and
- "Instructions for Completing Notification of Change in Corporate Permittee and/or Corporate Name (SMP-10)."

This form is for use by corporate permittees only. It is to be used (1) when an existing corporate permittee changes its name, and (2) when an existing corporate permittee has a change in any of its officers, directors, or 10 percent (or greater) voting stockholders. Failure to notify the Division of Permits could cause delays in processing future permit applications.

This form is not to be used to effect a transfer of a permit from an existing corporate permittee to a separate corporation. For transfers, form SMP-08, "Application for Transfer, Assignment or Sale of Permit Rights" must be used. These forms are also available in the Regional Offices and in Frankfort.
