
EMERGENCY AWARENESS BULLETIN

(EAB – No. 3 – 2018)

Kentucky DMS – Serious Accident No.2

On May 25, 2018, a 47-year-old outby foreman with 25 years of mining experience, 8 years at this occupation, was seriously injured while operating a continuous miner in the Hazard Branch.

The foreman was beside the machine moving the trailing cable, when a section of the mine roof measuring 66 inches long by 38 inches wide and 5 inches thick dislodged and struck him in the head and back, pinning him to the side of the machine, resulting in multiple head and facial fractures.

RECOMMENDATIONS TO PREVENT A SIMILAR OCCURRENCE

- 1. Conduct thorough examinations of the roof and rib where miners will work or travel.
- 2. When draw rock is present, it shall be taken down or adequately supported.
- 3. When second mining is being performed, frequent and thorough roof and rib examinations must be conducted due to changing conditions.
