EMERGENCY AWARNESS BULLETIN (BULLETIN - NO. 2 - 2020)

Kentucky DMS – Fatality No.1

On Friday October 9th 2020, a 48-year-old surface miner with approximately 27 years mining experience, 2 days at this mine, was fatally injured while working at a surface mine in the Harlan Branch.

The accident occurred while the victim was changing the nozzle on the hydro-seeder's discharge gun. The victim was positioned on top of the truck and after changing the nozzle on the gun, he was then struck by a release of energy as the pump engaged.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Provide additional training for all work procedures emphasizing best practices for each specific
- 2. Be aware of your location in relation to movement of equipment and any potential release of stored energy.
- 3. A safe means of locking and tagging-out, and blocking against motion of all equipment parts shall be provided where a potential hazard exists.
