1) Is it necessary to obtain a Right of Entry Consent if the operator has surface easement rights to operate and service the oil and gas wells through a valid and existing oil and gas lease?

Yes, it is necessary to obtain a Right of Entry Consent for each landowner and submit with the Well Nomination Form.

2) What is the maximum amount awarded per well for plugging cost or will it be based on a reimbursement basis with no maximum cost per well?

The selected wells will be put out for competitive bid through the Finance Cabinet. Contractors will be able to bid on the wells with their proposals and the proposals will be scored by a pre-set matrix. KDOG expects that not all eligible wells will be selected for plugging due to fund limitations.

3) How would you like us to denote the well site address? Lat/Long?
