Verify the following information on the transfer form: Permit Number, Lease Name, Well Number, County & Carter Coordinate Location A separate form must be completed for each lease.
All completion records on file Well Log & Completion Report & Electric Logs
Bond Status If the bond has been forfeited against the well(s) listed on the transfer form, the well(s) must be re-permitted.
Production Reports Submitted from 1997 through current year, if applicable. Production reports must be filed for all wells – not just the wells involved in the transfer.
Operator License \$100/year for commercial oil and gas wells. \$25/year for a domestic gas well.
Transfer Fees \$50 transfer fee for each well being transferred. All checks are made payable to the Kentucky State Treasurer.
As Built Plat must be filed, if applicable.
Inclination Survey must be filed, if applicable.
Gathering Line Permit & Map All wells must have topographic maps filed. If the well was permitted prior to March 18, 2004, only a topographic map is required. If the well was permitted March 18, 2004 or later, then an Application/Notification for Gathering Line Permit must be filed along with the topographic map.
The tenegraphic man should include the following:

The topographic map should include the following:

- Permit Number
- Location of the well
- Flow Lines
- Gathering Lines
- Indicate where the lines are connected
- the diameter
- the construction of the line
